**7 July 2019**

On the tenth anniversary of the conclusion of the Second Vatican Council, Pope Paul VI issued an Apostolic Exhortation on proclaiming the gospel. *Evangelii Nuntiandi*. Widely hailed then as an exceptionally dynamic document. It has stood the test of time so well that nearly forty years later Pope Francis quoted from it thirteen times in his own Apostolic Exhortation. *The Joy of the Gospel*. What did Paul VI have to say? Here's a sample passage that echoes today's word of God. "As an evangeliser, Christ first of all proclaims a kingdom, the kingdom of God; and this is so important that, by comparison, everything else becomes 'the rest'. Which is 'given in addition'. Only the kingdom therefore is absolute and it makes everything else relative.
