Dear Parents/Caregivers

We hope you had a wonderful holiday and have managed to enjoy some special family time.

In Week 4 we will be going on camp and on **Wednesday 10 February at 5.00 pm**, before the picnic we will be having a camp meeting for all parents. This will be to outline our programme and answer any questions you may have.

This year in Room 6, homework for students will consist of reading four nights a week, either a personal library book, and/or a reading book from school. In the first part of the term they will be bringing home books from their browsing boxes or they may choose to read a library book. Maths number knowledge learning will also begin after camp with students taking home their basic facts on a Thursday/Friday with 10 equations to learn and bringing these back the following Wednesday for buddy testing.

This may change occasionally but is the normal teaching cycle.
