Many of our students at St Joseph's School use bikes for a variety of purposes. To empower students to participate safely as responsible road users who are aware of their own place in the traffic environment, as well as that of others, we have organised for Police Constable Maire Froud to visit Rooms 7, 8 and 9 on Monday 4th November.

With each class, Maire will do both a theory and practical session. She will spend time looking at road and bike safety, traffic laws, and road hazards first, and then students will have the opportunity to use their bikes within the school grounds for a practical session.

Students who have bikes will need to have them at school on Monday 4th November along with their bike helmets. Those students who do not have a bike will still participate in the sessions and may be able to use another student's bike during the practical session.
