Dear Parents/Caregivers

The skiing students from Rooms 5,6,7,8 and 9 need to be at school by 7.00am for a 7.30 am departure.

The skiers will leave Roundhill at 3.30pm with an estimated return to school of 5.30 pm. This will be updated on the day via the Website, Facebook, and a text will be sent.

Helmet hire is now included in the students’ school group pricing. Helmets will be compulsory on the day. If students have their own ski/snowboard/skateboard or scooter helmets could they please bring them on the day.

All students receive a lesson on the day. Lessons are targeted to the level of the students ability.

Thank you to those who are offering their assistance at our skiing day at Roundhill. You will be assigned a small group of students (4-5) to supervise for the day. If you wish to ski, please pay your fees independently of the school.

We strongly encourage all the students to travel on the bus. If parents take their children off the bus it may mean the remaining students have to pay more or the trip cannot proceed. Over the last couple of years it has become apparent that the best way to get parents to Roundhill is to have them arrange their own transport and coordinate with each other. As a result of this we have hired sufficient room on the buses for the students only. Please contact James McCarthy if you are unable to find a ride.

Please assist the students in your group during the day with:

- checking items in their bags before we depart school
- meeting students off the bus at the ski field
- identifying with the students an area where their bags can be easily accessed during the day
- assisting with putting on skis
- supervising students when waiting for their lesson / time not on the snow / toilet etc.
- ensuring students are having regular snacks and eating lunch
- reminding students to be responsible for their clothing / rubbish
- The students **must** have a packed lunch and snacks with them please (Students are not able to purchase food from the cafe)
- Students will have a lesson as part of the day. The lessons are split to allow for lunch and a break
- All students will travel there and back by bus
- Invoice for the ski trip will be sent to all parents/caregivers after the event. This will ensure accuracy and avoid extra administration if the trips are cancelled.

Reminders for students

Wear your warm clothes to school.
Bring your helmet and your jacket.

In your bag you should have:

- over-trousers (waterproof)
- hat
- waterproof gloves
- spare clothes (extra polyprop, skivvy, sweatpants, gloves)
- sun glasses or ski glasses (**very important**)
- sunblock/lip protection
- small pack of tissues
- lunch box with lots of snacks
- drink bottle containing water.

Any medication should be carried by parents (inhalers, allergy) or given to your child's teacher if you are not going.
