Ski Trip 2019 - Final Notice

Dear Parents/Caregivers

This **Friday 16 August** is our school ski trip to Roundhill Ski Field for our Year 4 to 8 students.

We have nearly 120 students on the trip, split between three buses.

Below are important reminders about the day -

Arrive at school	7.00am for a clothing and gear check in the school hall. Depart school at 7.30am for Roundhill.
Return to school	5.00pm approximately - a text alert will go out when buses leave the ski field and again when they are through Fairlie.
Food and Drink	Large lunch and plenty of snacks. Water bottle. No student will be able to purchase food or drink at the ski field.
Clothing	Wear warm clothes to school. Also have: <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Jacket (warm and waterproof)● Ski pants or overpants (no jeans to be worn while on the ski field)● Thick warm socks● Sunglasses or ski goggles● Waterproof gloves● Warm hat/beanie● Sunblock (and also lip protection)● Spare clothes (polypro, socks, pants etc)● Helmet if you have one
Other	Remember to bring any necessary medication eg asthma inhalers. An excellent standard of behaviour is expected from our students. No devices or money for students please.
