## **MEGA MITRE 10 CART CHALLENGE NOTICE**

Dear Parents and Caregivers of Room 8 Year 6 students.

We have been invited to participate in an event next week at Mega Mitre 10 . Several schools in South Canterbury have had a pushcart delivered to assemble, decorate and then prepare a race team. The students must be year 6 and we will enter a team of two (pusher and driver). It would be great if those not driving could be there on the day to support.

On Thursday the 17<sup>th</sup> of June at 4pm, they will compete against the other schools in the aim of being fastest around the track, which will be in the Mega Mitre 10 carpark. The team and cart will need to be at our Mitre 10 MEGA carpark at 3:30pm all ready to race, in suitable clothing (long sleeves and pants), and also need a helmet to compete.

- The event is on Thursday the 17th June at Mega Mitre 10 carpark
- The children racing must have a long sleeve top and pants and a bike helmet to race.
- One student will be in the cart and one student will be the pusher around the course.

All teams will receive a fantastic donation to school courtesy of Mitre 10 MEGA and Hyundai South Canterbury.

1<sup>st</sup> \$500 donation , 2<sup>nd</sup> \$250 donation, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$200 donation & 4<sup>th</sup> \$150 donation, 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will receive a \$100 donation to their school, so all schools that enter will receive a donation.

If they need to postpone the cart race due to bad weather, we will hear in the morning and let all parents know. The race would then be held on a different day, to be confirmed.

I will be heading over straight after school so I am happy to take the students to meet parents/caregivers there.
