of all that is around us,

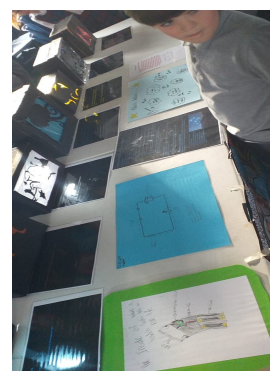
