Students will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and snacks for the first day. We will be having 'Takeaways' for dinner in Twizel later that day. The rest of the meals will be prepared on camp for the students.

As some parents' cars may have larger spaces for luggage, some students' gear will be put in a car different from the vehicle they are travelling in. Three parents, (Barry Grant, Garry Ballantyne and Andrew Brunton) who have Utes with canopies, will be able to take extra luggage and the extra food. All students must keep their morning tea and lunch accessible and with them in the vehicle they are travelling in please.

We will be leaving school at 9:00 am (latest) on **Wednesday 27 February**. Please check - [Car Groups, Activity Groups and Bunk Rooms](#) to see which car your child is travelling to and from camp in. We will return at approximately 3:00 pm on Friday 1 March.

Students in each 'bunk room' will be responsible for keeping their own room tidy during our stay. On Friday, before our departure, the students will clean their toilet and their bunk room with the help of parent supervision. Each bunk room sleeps ten and has its own toilet.
